### Diagnostic Analysis Adjustment Plan:

AMAPProject Managers and the Firm work together to develop a realistic strategy and an actionable plan for adjustment.

- Identifying competitive strengths weaknesses, opportunities, threat:
- Developing a customized adjustment plan
- Detailing the specific projects necessary to accomplish goals

The diagnostic analysis/adjustments plan is provided on a cost-shared basis. The MAP program pays 75% of the cost.



- Obtain outside technical assistance to implement the projects identified in Phase II.
- AMAP'sProject Managers assist Firms in the selection of outside professionals (consultants) for each project.
- The amount of total technical assistance is based on the number employees, sales revenue, and or degree of economic impact.

The AMAP program pays up to 50% of the fee per project.
